Ordered that the western shore Treasurer pay to Job Fowler three pounds, twelve shillings and six pence and the further Sum of Ten pounds, seventeen shillings and six pence specie for Wood purchased per Accounts passed. -

That the said Treasurer pay to Doct. Richard Lappington Twenty one pounds, nineteen shillings and six pence specie agreeable to the Act to adjust the Debts due from this State per Account passed. -
