burthen, navigated by thirty Men, mounting ten Carrage Guns belonging

John Angus Commander of the ship Carolina two hundred and fifty
Ton burthen, navigated by fifty Men, mounting sixteen Carrage Guns
belonging to John Wright Stanley of Philadelphia. —
