Ordered that the western shore Treasurer pay to Thomas Laneall two hundred and seven pounds, thirteen shillings and eight pence specie agreeable to the Act to adjust the Debts due from this state for four Certificates adjusted to the 1st of December 1702. -

That the said Treasurer pay to Henry Banning two hundred and ten pounds, twelve shillings and one penny. Thomas Harrison one hundred and sixty one pounds, fifteen shillings and two pence. Richard Parrott two hundred and forty eight pounds, two shillings and five pence and Elizabeth Spencer (Widow) eleven pounds, seventeen shillings and three pence specie agreeable to the Act to adjust the Debts due from this state per Certificates adjusted 19 November 1702. -

That the said Treasurer pay to Thomas Gackalls one pound eight shillings and six pence and John Lancaster two pounds, thirteen shillings and one penny specie due them per Accounts passed. -

That the said Treasurer pay to Captain James Somerville Twenty seven pounds, thirteen shillings specie out of the money that came from the Havana and put into the Treasury by General Smallwood on Account.
