Present His Excellency William Pownall Esquire Governor &

That the said Treasurer pay to William Spurrier Thirteen pounds, seven shillings and nine pence specie agreeably to the "Act to adjust the Debts due from this State" per Account passed. —

That the said Treasurer pay to William Harwood for the use of Mr. Dove Three pounds, nineteen shillings & six pence current Money due him of Acct. passed. —
