That the said Treasurer pay to John L. Markubin Thirty five pounds seventeen shillings and six pence and to Lewis Collins Twelve pounds, six shillings, and eight pence specie agreeably to the Act to adjust the Debt due from this State per Accounts passed. -

That the said Treasurer pay to Thomas Johnson Junior Two hundred Pounds current Money out of the Money appropriated for the Barges on account
