Courtenay Two hundred and six pounds, seven shillings and eleven pence Current Money  
Principal and Interest of a Certificate issued under the Act to adjust the Debts due from  
this State being for Clothing Contracted for by the Governor and Council. -

That the said Treasurer pay to John Loyal Fifteen pounds current  
Money, out of the money appropriated for the Hospital on Account

It appearing by the Certificate of Doct. Thomas Lint<sup>r</sup> of Frederick  
County, that Joseph Smith was fined Eighteen pounds, eighteen shillings and six pence  
for not attending from 1770 to 1781. and by his own Memorial and the certificates  
of respectable people, his Neighbours that he has been afflicted for many years  
past with a Fistula in ano, which rendered him incapable of a Militia Duty. Ordered  
that the said fine of Eighteen pounds, eight shillings and six pence be remitted. -
