That the said Treasurer issue a certificate to Richard Ridgely Esq<sup>r</sup> agreeably to the act aforesaid for One hundred and forty one pounds eleven shillings and ten pence due on Continental Loan Office certificates adjusted by the Depy And: the 20<sup>th</sup> instant.

That the said Treasurer pay to James McCulloch Eight hundred and thirty four pounds, four shillings and ten pence agreeably to the "act to adjust the Debts due from this state" for certificates adjusted by the Depy And: the 15<sup>th</sup> instant.

That the said Treasurer pay to Richard Ridgely for the use of Hercules Courtenay Two hundred and six pounds, seven shillings and eleven pence Current Money Principal and Interest of a certificate issued under the Act to adjust the Debts due from this state" being for Clothing Contracted for by the Governor and Council. -

That the said Treasurer pay to John Rizall Fifteen pounds current money, out of the money appropriated for the Hospital on Account.

It appearing by the Certificate of Doct: Thomas Lint<sup>th</sup> of Frederick County, that Joseph Smith was fined Eighteen pounds, eighteen shillings and six pence for not mustering from 1770 to 1781. and by his own Memorial and the certificates of respectable people, his Neighbours, that he has been afflicted for many years past with a Fistula in and, which rendered him incapable of a Military Duty.
