Ordered that the western shore Treasurers issue a Certificate to

on Loan. The Certificate is for sixteen pounds, eight shillings and five pence due on  
Continental Loan. The Certificate adjusted by the Deputy Auditor this Day. —

current money, out of the Money lodged in the Treasury for the use of the Hospital  
for Account paid. —

County exhibits an Account against Robert Christie formerly Sheriff of Baltimore County  
to the Amount of Five hundred and sixty two pounds seven shillings and seven pence  
in Virtue of the Act aforesaid passed by the Auditor General which is approved. —

Bond given by Lloyd Dulany to said Holstenholme which, with Interest, amounts to  
Sixty three pounds one shilling and six pence Sterling Money in Virtue of the Sup-  
plement to the "Act for the Liquidation of Debts" passed by the Auditor General, which  
is approved. —

Ordered that the western shore Treasurer pay to the Honorable

General Court each, One hundred pounds for a Quarter's Salary, ending  
this Day. —

offered to the Board, it is further postponed without a Day. —
