That the said Treasurer pay to Humphrey Pugh Fifteen pounds — Bernard O'Neil and William Deakins Junr. Sixty five pounds, six shillings and six pence and to Rob<sup>t</sup> Thomas Spragg Sixty eight pounds, eight shillings six pence agreeably to the "Act to adjust the Debt due from this State" per Accounts of Certificates adjusted & paid. —

That the said Treasurer pay to Thomas Johnson Junior Sixty two pounds, ten shillings current money for one Quarter's Salary ending the first instant
