

Jeremiah Townley (Esquire) elected a Member of the Council, attended and before Nicholas Worthington Esquire one of the Justices of our Arundel County, by taking the several Oaths required by the Constitution and Form of Government and the Laws of this State and by subscribing a Declaration of his Belief in the Christian Religion -

Ordered that the western Shore Treasurer issue Certificates agreeably to the Act proposing to the Citizens of this State Creditors of Congress &c. to Nicholas Worthington Esquire for Two hundred and twelve pounds, five shillings and nine pence and to Thomas Giler for One hundred and five pounds, ten shillings and eight pence due on Continental Loan Office Certificates adjusted by the Aud<sup>t</sup> Gen<sup>l</sup> the 1<sup>st</sup> Inst

That the said Treasurer issue a Certificate to Henry Ornel Welch agreeably to the Act aforesaid for One hundred and ninety five pounds, nineteen shillings and eight pence due him on Cont<sup>l</sup> Loan Office Cert<sup>s</sup> adjusted by the Aud<sup>t</sup> Gen<sup>l</sup> 21<sup>st</sup> Nov<sup>r</sup> last

That the said Treasurer issue a Certificate to John Bolton agreeably to the Act aforesaid for One hundred and sixty nine pounds and six pence due on Continental Loan Office Certificates adjusted by the Aud<sup>t</sup> General the 23<sup>rd</sup> Novemb<sup>r</sup> last

That the said Treasurer issue a Certificate to David Struick agreeably to the Act aforesaid for Two hundred and twenty three pounds, ten shillings and a half penny due on Continental Loan Office Certificates adjusted by the Auditor Gen<sup>l</sup> the 28<sup>th</sup> November last

That the said Treasurer pay to Elizabeth Haley and Catherine Sallwood, each, One pound two shillings and six pence current Money, out of the Money appropriated for Contingent Expenses, per Accounts passed -

That the said Treasurer pay to Philip Logg for the use of Major Aquila Giler Twenty pounds, five shillings and eleven pence half penny current Money for one Year's Interest on three Certificates issued under the "Act to adjust the Debts due from this State" issued and Dated the 18<sup>th</sup> May 1782 numbered 447 to 449.

That the said Treasurer pay to James Giler Thirty five pounds three shillings and three pence, John Quinner Four pounds five shillings and to Richard Seabrook Three pounds, ten shillings specie agreeably to the "Act to adjust the Debts due from this State" for Certificates and accounts passed by the Aud<sup>t</sup> G<sup>l</sup> the 1<sup>st</sup> Instant.
