On the request of the Intendant by letter dated 16th Instant, the Bond given by Robert Wood with Joseph Wood jun^r, Robert Gasaway and Azel Water his securities to the Honble Matthew Tighman President of the Convention of a Maryland dated 1st of August 1770 conditioned for the Payment of Three hundred pounds in Bills of Credit on the first of June next ensuing the Date, was delivered up to Joseph Wood jun^r one of the securities.

Ordered that the western shore Treasurer pay to Col^o Joseph Wood for the militia Guards at the Post of Fredericks Town under the Command of the late Capt Jacob Sells, one hundred and thirty four pounds, three shillings and four pence specie agreeably to the "Act to adjust the Debts due from this State" per payroll examined and passed the 21st of May 1783. -

Friday 19th December 1783.

Present as on yesterday. -

Ordered that the western shore Treasurer pay to Francis Belmeur Two pounds seven shillings and two pence current money for one year's Interest to the 22nd October last on a Certificate issued under the "Act to adjust the Debts due from this State"

That the said Treasurer pay to Thomas and Eleanor Landale Forty four pounds, nine shillings and nine pence current money for one year's Interest to the 5th of October 1783 on two Certificates issued under the Act aforesaid Number 633 & 634. -

That the said Treasurer pay to Thomas Beatty Esq^r nineteen pounds, ten shillings current money for one year's Interest on fourteen Certificates number 54 to the 19th Septem^r 1781 - 270 to the 11th August 1782 - 98 to the 16th August 1783 - 585, 588 & 592 to 4 September 1783 - 638 to 8 October 1783 - 1029 & 1030 to 16th October 1783 - 702 & 704 to 23rd October 1783 - 838 to 2^d December 1783 and 790 & 792 to the 17th December 1783 issued under the "Act to adjust the Debts due from this State" -

That the said Treasurer pay to Thomas Beatty Esq^r Two pounds ten shillings and nine pence farthing for one year's Interest on two Certificates n^o 270 to 11th August 1783 & 54 to 19th September 1782 issued under the Act aforesaid -

That the said Treasurer pay to Thomas Beatty one pound, sixteen shillings and five pence current money for one year's Interest on a Certificate to the 19th September 1783 number 54 issued under the Act aforesaid -

That the said Treasurer pay to Robert Long seventeen pounds eighteen shillings and nine pence and to Revill Horsly Four pounds, ten shillings and money due them per Account passed. -

That the said Treasurer pay to Luke Bamwell Three pounds eight shillings and four pence current money, out of the money lodged in the Treasury for the use of the Hospital per Account passed. -

That the said Treasurer pay to Frederick Grammer Four pounds nine shillings & ten pence current money due him on a receipt given by Charles Wallace 9th June 1780 adjusted by the aud^r Gen^l.

That the said Treasurer pay to Philip Key Eleven pounds, six shillings & one penny specie agreeable to the "Act to adjust the Debts due" if Act passed by the Convention the 15th Inst.
