On the request of the Intendant by Letter dated 16<sup>th</sup> instant, the Bond given  
by Robert Wood with Joseph Wood junior, Robert Giffaway and Abel Harton his chappellies  
to the Honble Matthew Tilghman president of the Legion of Maryland dated 1<sup>st</sup> August  
1770 conditioned for the Payment of Three hundred pounds in Bills of Credit on the first  
of June next ensuing the Date, was delivered up to Joseph Wood jun<sup>r</sup> one of the executors.

Ordered that the western shore Treasurer pay to Capt Joseph Wood for  
the Militia Guards at the Post of Frederick Town under the command of the late Capt  
Jacob Collins, One hundred and thirty four pounds, three shillings and four pence specie  
agreably to the "Act to adjust the Debts due from this State" per payroll examined and  
passed the 21<sup>st</sup> of May 1783. —

Friday 19<sup>th</sup> December 1783.

Present as on Yesterday. —

Ordered that the western shore Treasurer pay to Francis Belmore Two pounds  
seven shillings and two pence current money for one year's Interest to the 22<sup>nd</sup> October last on  
a certificate issued under the "Act to adjust the Debts due from this State"

That the said Treasurer pay to Thomas and Eleanor Landale Forty  
four pounds, nine shillings and nine pence current money for one year's Interest to the  
5<sup>th</sup> of October 1783 on two certificates issued under the Act aforesaid Number 633 & 634. —

That the said Treasurer pay to Thomas Beatty Esq<sup>r</sup> nineteen  
pounds, ten shillings current money for one year's Interest on fourteen certificates number  
54 to the 19<sup>th</sup> Septemt 1781- 270 to the 11<sup>th</sup> August 1782- 98 to 16<sup>th</sup> August 1783- 585. 588 & 592 to  
4 September 1783- 638 to 8 October 1783- 1029 & 1030 to 14<sup>th</sup> October 1783. 702 & 704 to 23<sup>rd</sup>  
October 1783- 838 to 2<sup>d</sup> December 1783 and 790 & 792 to the 17<sup>th</sup> December 1783 issued under  
the "Act to adjust the Debts due from this State" —

That the said Treasurer pay to Thomas Beatty Esq<sup>r</sup> Two pounds  
ten shillings and nine pence farthing for one year's Interest on two certificates No 270  
to 11<sup>th</sup> August 1783 & 54 to 19<sup>th</sup> September 1782 issued under the Act aforesaid —

That the said Treasurer pay to Thomas Beatty one pound, nineteen  
shillings and five pence current money for one year's Interest on a certificate to the 19<sup>th</sup>  
September 1783 number 54 issued under the Act aforesaid —

That the said Treasurer pay to Robert Long seventeen pounds  
eighteen shillings and nine pence and to Revill Horsley Four pounds, ten shillings and  
money due them per Account paid. —

That the said Treasurer pay to Luke Barnwell Three pounds,  
eight shillings and four pence current money, out of the money lodged in the Treasury for  
the use of the Hospital per Account paid. —

That the said Treasurer pay to Frederick Grammar Town  
fifteen pounds nine shillings & ten pence current money due him on a receipt given by Charles  
Wallace 9<sup>th</sup> June 1700 adjusted by the And<sup>r</sup> Gen<sup>r</sup>.

That the said Treasurer pay to Philip Key Eleven pounds, six  
shillings & one pence specie agreeable to the "Act to adjust the Debts due" first paid by the 11<sup>th</sup>  
of the 15<sup>th</sup> Inst.
