Present as on Yesterday. -

Ordered that the western shore Treasurer pay to Jonathan Parkhorn seven pounds, five shillings specie agreeably to the Act to adjust the Debt due from the State per Account passed by the said Gen<sup>l</sup> the 15<sup>th</sup> Inst.

That the said Treasurer pay to Thomas Bardon Ten pounds and to James Gajjards three pounds sixteen shillings specie agreeably to the Act above rec<sup>d</sup> per Accounts passed the 15<sup>th</sup> and 20<sup>th</sup> Instant.

That the said Treasurer pay to William Stevenson nine shillings and eight pence for one year Interest to the 22<sup>d</sup> November last on a Certificate issued under the Act to adjust the Debt per 22 November 1782 No. 426. -

That the said Treasurer pay to a Michael Miller Junior one pound eighteen shillings and three pence current per Account passed. -

Ordered that the western shore Treasurer pay to John Roberts Sixty five pounds sixteen shillings and three pence current money for one year Interest to the 2<sup>d</sup> November 1783. on a Certificate issued agreeably to the Act to adjust the Debt due from the State" number 428. -

That the said Treasurer pay to John Milmot Three pounds, fifteen shillings to Jonathan Miller two pounds, ten shillings and to George Ham twenty one pounds, six shillings and six pence current money due them per Accounts passed by the Auditor General. -

That the said Treasurer pay to George Ham Twenty seven pounds nine shillings and three pence current money for Interest arising on an Order to him dated the 15<sup>th</sup> August 1782 for Four hundred and eighteen pounds, fifteen shillings and ten pence stated and allowed by the said Gen<sup>l</sup>.

That the said Treasurer pay to George Ham Two hundred and eighty pounds two shillings and four pence current money due him per Account passed by the Auditor General. -

That the said Treasurer pay to John Giffall Two hundred and sixty three pounds, nine shillings current money due him on an Account passed by the said Gen<sup>l</sup> the 25<sup>th</sup> March 1782 and also Two pounds, twelve shillings and six pence pay penny like money due him per Account passed by the said Gen<sup>l</sup>.
