A Petition from Bryan Daley of Prince Georges County, was laid before the Board setting forth that he was Licensed as an Ordinary keeper in Prince Georges County and at the request of several Gentlemen attended at a Montgomery Court in August 1783 for the better accommodation of the Inhabitants of said County, thinking that a License enabled him to sell Liquors in any part of the State, but four Permits being found against him, he submitted to the Judgment of the Court, and they having no Decretionary powers, he was fined Twenty four hundred weight of Tobacco - and four of the Magistrates of said County certifying that the Facts contained in his Petition were true, and recommending the said fine to be remitted. the Board taking the same into Consideration, are of Opinion the said fine ought to be remitted and do order a Remission accordingly.
