

Thursday 10th February 1785

The Council met.

Present as on Yesterday.

Ordered that the western shore Treasurer pay to William Lee, one pound, sixteen shillings and six pence current Money amount of his Account for making Coats for James O'Hara and his Child by order of the Council, in Virtue of a Resolution of the General Assembly of July 1779.

That the said Treasurer pay to James O'Hara Two pounds, ten shillings current Money, forty shillings part thereof to be paid for One Month's Board to commence from the 11th of this Instant February, and ten shillings the residue to be retained by him for his own Expenses allowed him in Virtue of the above recited Resolution.

Commissions issued to Joshua Beall, David Craufurd, Richard Henderson, Thomas Clagett, Osborn Sprigg, Tulder Bowie, Thomas Boyd, William Berry James Mullikin, James Beck, Henry Rejor, Frank Leeke, Samuel Hepburn, John Brown, Abraham Boyd, John Smith Brookes, Rinaldo Johnson, and Robert Bowie appointed Justices of the Peace for Prince Georges County and to Joshua Beall, David Craufurd, Tulder Bowie, Frank Leeke, Samuel Hepburn, John Smith Brookes and Rinaldo Johnson appointed Justices of the Orphans Court of Prince Georges County.

The Council adjourned till tomorrow 11 o'clock.
