That the Said Treasurer pay to Thomas Jones Esquire Fifty pounds Current Money for one quarter's Salary as one of the Judges of the Court of Appeals, ending the 1<sup>st</sup> Instant

James Hallyday Attorney for George Rome, exhibits to this Board an Account against James Chalmers amounting with Interest to the 1<sup>st</sup> of October 1784 to One thousand, five hundred and sixty six pounds, which is examined and approved.

Peter Engels of Frederick County is hereby appointed Armourer at Frederick Town in virtue of the "Act to vest certain powers in the Governor and the Council."
