Ordered that the western shore Treasurer pay to William Layman Executor of Rachel Torry Twenty eight pounds, two shillings and eight pence specie agreeably to the "Act to adjust the Debts due from this State" per Account passed by the Auditor General 10th November 1785.

That the Said Treasurer pay to William Harwood Twenty five pounds current Money for One Quarter's Salary as Ed of the House of Delegates ending the 1st Instant

That the Said Treasurer pay to Solomon Wright Esquire One hundred pounds current Money for half a year's Salary as One of the Judges of the Court of Appeals ending the 1st Instant
