That the Said Treasurer pay to Samuel Willson one pound six shillings and ten pence specie agreeably to the "Act to adjust the Debt due from this State" per Account passed by the Auditor General.

That the Said Treasurer pay to John Gaffaway Seventeen pounds and three pence current Money due him as an Assistant to the Auditor General per Account passed.
