That the said Treasurer pay to Robert Gordon for the use and by Order of Robert & Co Lead Twelve pounds, ten shillings current Money the five Months pay due him as a private of the 6th Maryland Regiment from 1 August 1780 to 1 January 1781 per Certificate of the Auditor General.

That the said Treasurer pay to Thomas Dillard Forty two pounds four shillings and eight pence specie agreeable to the "Act to adjust the Debts due from from this State" per Certificate passed by the Deputy Auditor the 14 August 1783.
