

Ordered That the western shore Treasurer pay to Benjamin Hanford  
Adm<sup>r</sup> of Joseph Kernick late a Soldier of the 1<sup>st</sup> Regiment Twelve pounds, ten  
shillings current Money for Pay from 1<sup>st</sup> August 1780 to 1<sup>st</sup> January 1781 per  
certificate of the Auditor General.

That the said Treasurer pay to David Stewart and David Plunket  
One hundred and five pounds, eight shillings and four pence current Money in lieu  
of sixty three pounds five shillings sterling for their Passages of and advances  
made the following indentured Servants for the State and to be charged to them  
in the proportions following and to be deducted from their Wages viz to Dennis  
Kerney, Anthony Jones, Michael Butler and Maurice Roche each Twenty one  
pounds, fifteen shillings current Money and to Hugh Sackhoff Eighteen pounds  
Eight shillings and four pence like money. —

That the said Treasurer pay to John Olney Seven pounds  
sixteen shillings and seven pence. James Hutchings Eighteen pounds five shillings  
and three pence. James Hutchings Adm<sup>r</sup> of John Price Eighty two pounds  
Eighteen shillings and six pence, and to Elizabeth Jones Adm<sup>r</sup> of William  
Kirby Jones Eighteen pounds, sixteen shillings and one penny specie agree-  
ably to the Act to adjust the Debts due from this State per Account  
passed by the Auditor General the 1<sup>st</sup> June last —

That the said Treasurer pay to Charles Lawdale Twelve  
pounds, ten shillings current Money for the Carriage of Public Letters one  
year per Account passed by the Auditor General. —

The Council adjourned till tomorrow morning 11 O'clock.
