Mrs Mary Hillery, the Widow of Rignal Hillery late
a Lieutenant in the Maryland Line and who died in the Service, having applied
to the Board for the Benefit of the Act of last Session providing relief to Per-
sons of her description the Board agreeably to the direction to them contained
in the said Act, made enquiry into the circumstances of the said Mary Hillery
and finding that her case merits the full benefit of the aforesaid Act do order
that the said Mary Hillery receive in quarterly Payments, commencing the
Eighth of March 1786 the Sum of Sixty pounds per Annum during the
Operation of the Act it being half the Pay to which her Husband was en-
titled during his Service.

Ordered That the western shore Treasurer pay to Mary
Hillery Widow of the late Lieut Rignal Hillery Fifteen pounds current
Money for three Months half pay ending the 8th June last agreeably to the
determination of this Board.
