Ordered that the western shore Treasurer pay to George
Murdoch Esquire Three hundred and seventy five pounds to be delivered over to Francis Deakins
to be by him expended in defraying one half of the Expence of examining, surveying, cutting,
clearing, improving and keeping in repair a proposed road from the waters of Potomack
river to the river Cheat agreeably to a Resolue of the General Assembly of November Session
1781 for which he is to account

That the said Treasurer pay to Mess^{rs} Carey & Tilghman Three
hundred and twenty two pounds, seventeen shillings and six pence on the Order of Mess^{rs}
Willing, Morris and Swanwick of the 7th August last, for so much advanced, including commissions
of Mess^{rs} Hunt, to William Harrison & Nathaniel Ramsey Esquires Delegates in Congress and
also to the said Mess^{rs} Carey & Tilghman the further sum of One hundred and eighty four
pounds, ten shillings on the Order of the said Willing, Morris & Swanwick of the 24th October
last for so much (including commissions) advanced to John Henry & Nathaniel Ramsey
Esquires which sums are to be charged to the said Delegates -

That the said Treasurer pay to George Murdoch Esq^r
two hundred & fifty seven pounds, fourteen shillings & seven pence specie agreeably to
the "act to adjust the Debt due from this State" per Account adjusted by the Auditor
General to the 19th February last 1782
