That the said Treasurer pay to Edward Jenkins jun^r One hundred seven shillings and eight pence due agreeably to the Act to adjust the Debts due from this State per Account passed by the Aud^r Gen^l the 30th Jan^y last

That the said Treasurer pay to Sarah Denny Seven pounds fifteen shillings due agreeably to the Act to adjust the Debts due from this State per Account passed by the Auditor General
