Richard Shaw of Cecil County by his Petition to the Board sets forth that to prevent a certain William Caldwell from confinement or two Prefectments he entered into two Recognizances of Twenty pounds each for the appearance of the said Caldwell who shortly after absconded, and has not, to the Petitioners knowledge been since in the County in consequence of which the Petitioner is now in confinement, as well for the Payment of expenses of a certain pounds Officers fees as the amount of the said Recognizances whereupon the Board taking into consideration the large amount of the Expence which has arisen on the Accountments and finding the facts set forth to be certified by three Justices of the said County do order a Remission of the said two Sums of Twenty pounds each, and they are accordingly remitted

In Council March 15th 1787

Henry Wagon of Harford County by his Petition sets forth that at the last November Court held for the County aforesaid he was presented for selling spiritous Liquors without a license, and on a Subjimpson was held to have committed the offence and subjected to the forfeiture in the act of Assembly mentioned. The Petitioner pleads in extenuation of his breach of the Law, that he had purchased a barrel of Rum with the intention of procuring license to retail it; but before this was done he lost his house and most of his property by fire, when being much distressed, he offered the said Barrel of Rum to his Landlord in part payment of his Rent; who through compulsion would not take it, but advised him to make a profit by retailing, which at last his distresses forced him to do - that having sold a small quantity to Peter Williams constable, the said Williams presented him as a forger. The Petitioner being thus at the Mercy of the State, prays a Remission of his forfeiture whereupon the Board taking into consideration the (Misfortune) riches and Recommendation signed by five Justices of the aforesaid County, do direct that the said forfeiture be a it is hereby remitted
