and also to William Crookshank's Adm^r Fifteen pounds, twelve shillings and six pence
due for five months pay as Trumpeter and Troopers in Lees Legion from 1st August 1780
to 1st January 1781 per Certificates of Auditor General.

Money per Account passed by the Deputy Auditor.
