That the said Treasurer pay to James Bruce Esquire Eighteen pounds fifteen shillings for one quarter's Salary as a member of the Council

That the said Treasurer pay to Joseph Stark Four hundred and thirty two pounds, nine shillings and one penny for Disbursements on the public Buildings to the 21 April last per account examined by the Auditor General

That the said Treasurer pay to John Killy Esquire Eighteen pounds, fifteen shillings for one quarter's Salary as a member of the Council

That the said Treasurer pay to James Amaman Esquire Eighteen pounds fifteen shillings for one quarter's Salary as a member of the Council

That the said Treasurer pay to John Rogers Esquire One hundred and eighty seven pounds, ten shillings for one quarter's Salary as Chancellor due this Day

That the said Treasurer pay to Samuel Bayard Forty nine pounds and three pence specie agreeably to the "Act to adjust the Debts due from this State per account passed by the Auditor General the 30 April last
