

Saturday 19<sup>th</sup> May 1787

The Council met

Present His Excellency William Smallwood Esquire

Ordered that the western shore Treasurer pay to Peter Engels Two hundred pounds for the use of the Armoury at Frederick Town in his charge and to be accounted for

That the said Treasurer pay to James Sullwain, One hundred and forty two pounds fourteen shillings and five pence specie agreeably to the act to adjust the Debts due from this State per account passed by the Deputy Auditor

That the said Treasurer pay to John Brown Twenty five pounds twelve shillings and nine pence specie agreeably to the act to adjust the Debts due from this State per certificate adjusted by the Deputy Auditor the 13<sup>th</sup> Instant

The Honorable John Kelly Esquire attended

Ordered That the western shore Treasurer pay to Charles Rankin Eight pounds fifteen shillings due him for the like sum paid into the Treasury on a Warrant to effect a part of the reserved Lands

The Council a May 19<sup>th</sup> 1787

Dr Francis Keale having by his Petition set forth that he was prosecuted in Harford County Court for assaulting a certain Hannah Coog and conceiving himself innocent of the charge intended traversing the same by Jury but a material witness of his being absent he could not with safety proceed to trial - that he used his utmost endeavors to procure the benefit of the Testimony of said Witness by frequently having issued against him Subpoenas and Attachments all to no effect that in consequence of a delay of the trial - he was recognized by the Court aforesaid in the sum of ten pounds Sterling - that he daily attended every Court agreeably to the tenor of his Recognizance until last March Court when he was called out to a patient and during the time being the fourth day of the Court the Recognizance was forfeited
