Francis Deakins One hundred and fifty pounds current money to be expended in defraying the expenses attending the laying out and surveying the lands, the property of the State, to the westward of Fort Cumberland agreeably to a Resolution of the General Assembly, on Account

Ordered that Mr. John Shaw deliver to Sgt. Francis Deakins six Tents to be used in laying out the Lands westward of Fort Cumberland, for which he is to Account
