Ordered That the Western Shore Treasurer pay to George Bear thirty five pounds Current Money due him for taking care of the Magazine near Frederick Town & Account ordered by the Auditor General,

Robert Hammit of Frederick County by his petition to the Board, sets forth, that he hath rented at a very high rate, a ferry on Monocacy river, and that through Ignorance of the Law, he proceeded to keep the same without procuring licence, in consequence of which he was presented and fined by the Court of said County in the sum of five pounds current money - a transcript of which proceeding accompanied the petition - The Petitioner represents that he has a numerous family whom he is but barely able to support, and who must greatly suffer by the laying the fine aforesaid, and ten of the Justices of the said County having declared their Opinion that the facts set forth are true, and having recommended a Remission of the fine, The Board in consideration of all the circumstances do Order and direct that the said fine of five pounds be and it is hereby remitted.
