Ordered That the Western Shore Treasurer pay to James McHenry Esquire four hundred pounds, current money, in part of an Order of Council of the 15th of March last, for "One thousand five hundred and seventy six pounds, thirteen Shillings and two pence current money, arising due on a purchase of Bills of Credit Issued by Congress made by Mess^{rs}. McHenry & Hindman, in virtue of a contract made with them by the late Intendant, under the Authority of a Resolution of the Assembly of the thirty first of May 1783" now delivered in.
