

Indictment for Felony- and by the non attendance of the said Elizabeth Easton

a wife and four small Children, who are in the utmost distress for want
of his support- pray a remission of the said forfeiture-and eight of the
Justices of the said County having recommended him the said William Armstrong
to the mercy of Government- The Board taking the same into Consideration,
do order and direct the said forfeited Recognizance of fifty pounds to be,
and it is hereby remitted
