John Anthony Honore formerly a subject of the King of France who arrived in this State in the year 1782, appeared before the Board and did voluntarily make, repeat, and subscribe a Declaration of his belief in the Christian religion, and also took, repeated and subscribed the Oath prescribed by the Act for Naturalization - wherefore he is now become a subject of this State.

Ordered that John Shaw Armourer in the City of Annapolis deliver to Thomas Russell Esq^r for the use of the Justices of the Criminal Court for Baltimore County, twenty stands of Arms fit for immediate use with twenty Bayonets and twenty Cartouch boxes, which they are to return in good order or to have replaced by Baltimore County or to pay for them
