John Baker of Baltimore County who was fined six pounds current money by the Criminal Court for Baltimore County at June term last for retailing liquors by the small without licence having set forth by his petition that he a Carpenter by trade finding business in a declining state was induced to sell liquors to help to support a wife and three small children one of whom is very sickly - that the fine if paid will greatly distress his family which is certified by a number of Inhabitants of Baltimore County, and three of the Justices of the said Court having recommended the Petitioner for relief, We do order that of the said fine the sum of four pounds ten shillings be and it is hereby remitted
