The Council met

Ordered that the western shore Treasurer pay to Randolph B. Latimer Two pounds, eight shillings and eleven pence and him per Account papered by the Aud^g Gen^l.

That the said Treasurer pay to Capt. Beniah Maybury four pounds nine shillings and eight pence specie agreeably to the "Act to adjust the Debts due from this State" per Certificate adjusted by the Deputy Aud^g and the 1st September 1787.

That the said Treasurer pay to Mrs. Mary Hilleary, widow of the late Lieut. Rignat Hilleary Thirty pounds for six months half pay due to her the 1st May last.
