That the said Treasurer pay to Charles Sandale Twenty five pounds for two years carriage of public Letters per Account passed by the Deputy Auditor

That the said Treasurer pay to Michael Miller six pounds eleven shillings and ten pence and to John Miller five pounds seven shillings and seven pence agreeably to the "Act to adjust the Debts due from this State" and the 1st September 1787 per Accounts adjusted by the Deputy Auditor
