Whereas it appears by a transcript from the Clerk of
Baltimore County Criminal Court that Thomas White was fined six hundred pounds
of Tobacco at June term last by the Justices of said Court for selling liquors without
License, and by the Petition of the said Thomas White that he has a wife and
three small Children that he owned a horse and Dray by which he supported his
family and which he is now deprived of, and that he had his house blown down in
the late storm which has completed his ruin - The Board in consideration of
the indigent Circumstances of the said Thomas White, and his being recommended
as an object of clemency by four of the Justices of the said Court, do direct that
the said fine of six hundred pounds of Tobacco be remitted, which is hereby
