Col. Jeremiah Banning Armourer in Talbot County is hereby authorized to demand and receive all public Arms and Military Stores in the hands of the inhabitants of the said County agreeably to an Act of Assembly passed at November Session 1785 —

Saturday 14<sup>th</sup> March 1789.

The Council met

Present as on yesterday.

Ordered that the western Shore Treasurer pay to William Hindman Esq. thirty seven pounds ten shillings Current Money for one quarter's Salary as a Member of the Council —

That the said Treasurer pay to William Hughlett Six pounds for his detention in January last, three Days, and delivering letters in Queen Anne's, Kent, Cecil, and Caroline Counties respecting the Election of Electors and Representatives allowed him by the Board. —

The Council adjourned till Monday morning —
