Ordered that the western shore Treasurer pay to Samuel Chaffett Ten pounds, two shillings and six pence Current Money and four per cent per Account passed by the Auditor General.

That the said Treasurer pay to Thomas Smyth six hundred and seventeen pounds, ten shillings and eleven pence, specie agreeably to the "Act to adjust the Debts due from this State" per Account examined and passed by the Auditor General, and the 1st September 1787.

In Council April 8th 1789

John Cartwright Esquire Collector of taxes for St. Marys County having prayed the indulgence which by an Act of Assembly passed at their last Session entitled "An Act to empower the Governor and Council to compound with the discoverers of butyls property, and for other purposes," this Board is authorized to grant on certain conditions, which conditions the said John Cartwright has complied with, and the Board being of opinion that he has used his best endeavours to discharge the balance he owes to the State - Resolved that all proceedings at law against the said John Cartwright or his Secy for the balance due from him to the State for the taxes in St. Marys County aforesaid in the year 1786 be suspended for three months.
