Jane Tate of Baltimore town by her Petition, sets forth, that she hath been presented to the Court of Oyer and Terminer for Baltimore County, and fined six hundred pounds of Tobacco, and thirty shillings, for selling liquors without licence — that Cyder was the only liquor sold, and she was ignorant that it was necessary to take out licence for that purpose — that she is a widow in very indigent circumstances with five small children, and prays a Remission of said fine, and three of the Justices of the said Court having recommended her to the attention of the Board as a person who they believe has a family of children and is very poor — Ordered that the said fine of six hundred pounds of Tobacco and thirty shillings be and the same is hereby remitted
