Sufficient Evidence having been produced to this Board that Mess^{rs} Stewart and Plunket of Baltimore Town lost in the Storm of the 24th July last, two thousand seven hundred and two and an half bushels of Salt, four hundred and twenty eight bushels thereof imported in the Brigantine Conyngham, and the residue, two thousand two hundred and seventy four and an half bushels in the Brig Rofs packet the Duties thereon having been secured to be paid to the Naval Officer of the fourth District. Ordered that the said Naval Officer be and he is hereby required to discount with or refund to the said Stewart and Plunket the duties on the said Salt —
