Thomas Clark of St Kings County by his Petition sets forth that at June Court seventeen hundred and eighty eight for said said County, he was fined six pounds current Money for selling spiritous Liquors contrary to Law, for which fine he was committed - that he is unable to pay the fine, being very poor and has a large family, and five of the Justices of the said County having represented the Petitioner as in very indigent Circumstances and in other respects a harmless inoffensive man - The Board in consideration of his confinement and poverty do direct that the said fine of six pounds be remitted.
