

In Council August 12<sup>th</sup> 1789

Sufficient Evidence having been given the Board that Thomas Anderson and Company of Chester town Kent County lost on the 25<sup>th</sup> of July 1788 the quantity of two thousand bushels of Salt on which the Duties had been Levied to be paid to the Naval Officer of the eighth District. Ordered that the said Naval Officer be required to discount with or refund to the said Thomas Anderson and Company the Duties on the said Salt. By order

John Stull, Joseph Chapline, Thomas Sprigg, Alexander Haggett and Ignatius Taylor appointed Justices of the Orphans Court of Washington County.
