tices of the Criminal Court for Baltimore County - Samuel Johnston in
place of Thomas Russell deceased

Ordered that the western shore Treasurer pay to
David Lynn, one of the Commissioners to dispose of the land westward of Fort
Cumberland or Forty three pounds, three shillings and three pence a balance
due to him as per account passed by the Auditor.

That the said Treasurer pay to the said David
Lynn Thirty pounds, fifteen pounds part thereof to be by him delivered
over to Capt Daniel Frejav and the residue to Major Benjamin Brookes Com-
missioners appointed to dispose of the reserved Lands westward of Fort Cumberland
to be by them accounted for.

The Council adjourned till tomorrow morning.
