In Council November 30th 1789

John Wall of Baltimore County by his Petition
sets forth that he entered into a Recognizance in the Sum of twenty pounds current
Money for the appearance of Nathaniel Mikes at the August Term of the Court
of Oyer and Terminer for the said County to answer a presentment and Indictment
for receiving stolen goods - that the said Mikes has since absconded, by which
the Petitioner's Recognizance has become forfeited - that he has expended a
considerable Sum of Money in pursuit of the said Mikes without effect, and
therefore prays a Remission of the forfeiture - the petition is accompanied
by a Court transcript certifying the proceeding - and by a Recommendation from
three Justices of the aforesaid Court who certify their belief in the facts set
forth - It is moreover represented that he supports an aged Father and Mother,
and that he has lost a debt due to him from Mikes by his flight - All
which being considered, it is ordered that of the above forfeiture of twenty pounds
nineteen pounds be remitted -
