

moreover if the parties should fail to satisfy the Board at their first application and should not have left time to amend what is defective within the limited space they will certainly lose the opportunity of installing; as the Board are resolved to adhere implicitly to the direction of the Act -

Lastly the debtors are cautioned to pay a strict attention to the forms presented by the Act for authenticating their writings of consent &c. The excuse of small deviations would lead to the introduction of greater. The parties may therefore assure themselves that any negligence in this particular will subject them to disappointment.
