Terrace above the Dome one substantial rough flight of Stairs of such
Dimensions as shall be directed by the Governor and Council or any other
person they shall appoint for that purpose, for the Sum of Eighty Dollars,
the Governor and Council allowing the Subscribers to use as many of the
materials as they will want for the purpose that are now in the upper
