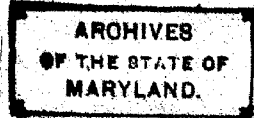


He was presented at August Court 1789 and fined 500^d of Tobacco and Costs of

lately released under the insolvent law, and is unable to pay the fine - That an

he ought to be relieved - The Board in consideration of all the circumstances
do order and direct that the said fine of 500 pams of Tobacco be remitted
