

Sarah Shadruck - and Alderson for the appearance of Frances Savage

tenor of their recognizances, but being ignorant that they ought to have applied
to the Attorney General to be sent to the Grand Jury they neglected so to do,
and not being present when their names were called, their recognizances be-
-came forfeited - whereupon Execution hath issued against the Petitioners
they therefore pray that the said forfeitures may be remitted - and three of
the Justices of the said Court having recommended them to Government for
relief - The Board in consideration of all the circumstances do order and
direct that the said forfeitures of ten pounds each be remitted on their
paying the Costs accruing thereon
