Ordered that the western shore Treasurer pay to Thomas Johnson jmt. Thirty six pounds, five shillings and five pence due him per account passed, and also the further sum of one hundred and twenty five pounds for six months salary as Clerk of the Council due the 1st instant

That the said Treasurer pay to Mrs Mary Hilleary widow of Lieut Rignel Hilleary Forty five pounds for nine months half pay due the 1st instant

That the said Treasurer pay to Colo John Hoskins Store Forty two pounds, three shillings and nine pence for three months half pay due the 1st instant

That the said Treasurer pay to John Hyde Two pounds, eight shillings and nine pence for one pair of Boots for Thomas Wallcy

That the said Treasurer pay to John Shaw Seven pounds, eleven shillings and six pence due him per account passed by the Auditor General and also the further sum of Twenty five pounds for six months salary as Annoucer at Annapolis due the 1st instant

The Petition of James Moore Goaler of Harford County praying the remission of a fine imposed on him at November Court of said County for selling spiritous liquors by small measure without licence, being read, the same was rejected
