

Agreeably to a Resolution of the General Assembly  
William Campbell is appointed by the Board to receive in behalf of the

Works heretofore sold to John Dorsey of Baltimore County.

Agreeably to a Resolution of the General Assembly  
The Board have appointed William Campbell to sell and convey the rights  
of the State to One hundred acres of land at Fort Detrick in Washington  
County for a price payable in three equal <sup>annual</sup> payments for which the Board  
agree to allow him a remission of two and a half per cent on the  
sum of Money paid or secured to be paid for the same —

Ordered that the western shore Treasurer pay to John

to be expended in procuring Books for the purpose of transcribing such
